1. POLICY: Fire protection district elections shall be held on the Tuesday following the first Monday in November of odd-numbered years.

A person may become a candidate for the office of fire commissioner by filing a declaration of candidacy with the county auditor during the July filing period as prescribed by law. In the event that there are more than two candidates for any position on the Board, a primary election shall held in the manor prescribed by law and the Mason County Auditor. The two candidates receiving the greatest number of votes will appear on the election ballot in November.

A person is legally qualified to become a fire commissioner who is a United States citizen, and a qualified voter and resident of the fire protection district. A commissioner may not serve as a firefighter or EMS responder member in the district unless approved by a majority of the board and the Fire Chief.
