All Fire District members are expected to represent the District to the public in a professional manner, which is courteous, efficient and helpful. Members must maintain a clean and neat appearance appropriate to their work assignment, as determined by the Fire Chief.

Since the proper working relationship between members and the Fire District depends on each employee's on-going job performance, professional conduct and behavior, the Fire District has established certain minimum standards of personal conduct. Among the Fire District's expectations are: basic tact and courtesy towards the public and fellow members; adherence to District policies, procedures, safety rules and safe work practices; compliance with directions from supervisors; preserving and protecting the Fire District's equipment, grounds, facilities and resources; and providing orderly and cost-efficient services to its citizens.
