The following are the minimum standards for acceptance as a volunteer member;

- 1) Be at least 18 years of age.
- 2) Possess a valid Washington State driver's license. Non-drivers must possess a valid Washington State Identification Card
- 3) Be in good physical health and be able to perform tasks commensurate with their job description.
- 4) Authorize and undergo a character background investigation; (criminal, driving, reference history, public record)
- 5) While representing the fire district; maintain a courteous, honest, professional level of conduct towards fellow members and the public.
- 6) Approval of the Fire Chief and the Board of Commissioners.
- 7) Maintain activity level commensurate with assigned job description.
  - a) Resident Firefighter engages in at least 50% of monthly incidents.
  - b) Volunteer schedules and participates 48 hours of stand-by/stipend shiftwork, 4 12-hour shifts, or 6 8-hour shifts, per month.
  - c) CERT/Support Personnel schedules and participates in 8 hours of stand-by/stipend shift per month.
