**PURPOSE:** To insure safe and effective emergency operations in route, during and after all emergency events whether they be Fire, EMS, Rescue, Hazardous Materials or any All Risk event. To also insure safe and effective operations during training drills, community events, and while at stations or in department vehicles.

**RESPONSIBILITIES:** It is the responsibility of **each** individual member to ensure they are in compliance with this guideline. It is the responsibility of the Fire Chief to enforce this guideline.

**GUIDELINE:** All training and fire ground activities shall be in accordance of the current edition of the Essentials of Fire Fighting as authored by the International Fire Service Training Association (IFSTA), and referenced by NFPA 1001.

All Emergency Medical operations shall be in compliance of the current version of the Mason County Pre-Hospital Care Protocols. This includes the Mass Casualty Incident (MCI) plan adopted by Mason County EMS Council.

Mason County Fire District #4 is mandated to follow the current edition of the Safety Standards for Fire Fighters Chapter 296-305 WAC, as per the Department of Labor and Industries. All members must adhere as closely as humanly possible to these safety standards at all times.

As per Chapter 296-305 WAC the department has in place Exposure Control Plan for Bloodborne/Airborne Pathogens, and a Respiratory Protection Program that all members must adhere to.

All members will have updated copies of all Policies/Procedures, Standard Operating Guidelines. All new members will be given a copy of a Handbook with policies during their probationary year.
