Mason Fire District #4 enjoys partnerships with our fire service neighbors. In order to assist our partners with a mutual aid request, personnel responding to this request should;

1. Proceed to Station-46 (Golden Pheasant), the first arriving member assumes the position of Assembly Officer. Station-46 is a central station for this fire district with (normally) sufficient resources to grant the needs of our partners and our own personnel.
2. Conduct an accountability of personnel to assure the appropriate skill level (of the crew) is established per the mutual aid request. (Structural firefighters, EMT/EMS, rescue technicians, tender operators).
3. Consider the need to hold or release the remainder of apparatus and/or personnel at the assembly point for the protection of the fire district. Should the Assembly Officer dissolve his/her position prior to the return of the mutual aid crew, this should be communicated with the responding officer.

\*\*\*\* In order to maintain the maximum margin of SAFETY, apparatus en route to the assembly point should respond routine. (code yellow).
